The Role

Responsible for negotiating various revenue and expense Right-of-Way Agreements and 3rd Party Conduit/ Pole Agreements related to the Company's telecommunications network across North America. Manages numerous negotiations simultaneously as well as develops and delivers progress reports and various metrics for the Network Infrastructure Services department. Contract negotiation will include but not be limited to the following: projects involving network growth and integrity, use of third party assets (including utility poles and conduits), management of rights-of way, franchise and other licenses necessary for the placement and operation of the network. Contract negotiation and management will include full life cycle of sale and purchase contracts terms, conditions, operational and financial impact.

The Main Responsibilities

Knowledge, Skills or Abilities

Experience in contract negotiation and management is required. High level proficiency of Microsoft Office is essential. Experience in outside plant design and/or construction, or network planning is preferred. Additional experience in business management, financial management or the legal field is preferred. Must possess regulatory knowledge as it pertains to the telecommunications industry. Must be strong multi-tasker and have experience coordinating across departments. Ability to communicate and build concurrence with various departments including Operations, Legal and Finance. Experience with interfacing with various municipal agencies is required. Must have good visual acuity. Must be able to work in a general office environment and be able to operate a computer and associated peripherals. Must be able to operate a telephone and communicate effectively with same.

Essential Duties

• Acts as primary manager for those assigned projects within the Contract Manager's territory.

• Acts as primary lead for the negotiation and acquisition of right-of-way, franchise agreements and infrastructure contracts such as pole, dark fiber agreements or conduit agreements.

• Ability to mine data from various data repositories.

• Ability to raise and settle contract use and financial disputes.

• Coordinates delivery and integration of right of way and infrastructure components with other functional groups.

• In cooperation with other functional groups, develops projects related to network expansion,

operation and maintenance, requiring right-of-way agreements or third party asset acquisition.

• Provides estimated costs of various right of way and infrastructure components of projects related to building additions or network expansion/integration projects.

• Provides right of way and infrastructure related expertise as needed by the company.

• Provides support to post execution management of various right of way and infrastructure agreements to include: assembling contract deliverables, proper entry of related data into company tracking and financial databases, payment and analysis of invoices, contract renewals, etc.
