Job Description:

This position is 100 percent travel. You will work for 40 hours with Saturdays/Sundays off. Travel will be 4-6 weeks with 1 week off at home. All Federal holidays off and paid vacation. All travel expenses paid with per diem.

This position is "On Call" meaning you will work when we have it available. This is not full-time and benefits are not paid.

Program Overview:

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) awarded the Technical Support Services Contract 4 (T4) to Parsons as the prime contractor. This \$1.3 billion+ contract has a 4-year base period with two 3-year options. The statement of work includes a variety of activities that support the FAA's Capital Investment Plan (CIP) modernization efforts: Site selection and engineering, construction, environmental and fire/life safety, equipment installation and testing, CAD, and other technical services as required. Work is performed across the nation in each of the FAA's nine regions as well as the Aeronautical Center in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, and the Technical Center in Atlantic City, New Jersey and in several U.S. territories. An average staff of 400-500 with a peak staff over 650 supports this contract, in addition to those subcontractors who perform construction work.

POSITION OVERVIEW:

The Resident Engineer will be able to perform routine and well-defined quality control inspection activities on assigned project and/or functional areas to ensure that products or services provided are in accordance with customer and Parsons's requirements.

- + Performs other functions associated with this position as appropriate.

- + Ability to read and understand drawings, codes, standards, and specifications.
- + Basic computer skills, including, but not limited to, MS Windows, MS Word, and MS Excel. Proficiency in utilizing scheduling software.
- + Willingness to Travel.
- + Must be able to pass government background check.
- + Experience using CAD software such as MicroStation or AutoCAD.
- + Experience taking photographs using a digital camera in addition to uploading files/photographs to a computer/memory device or internet site.
